Rider Entry Terms for Strathconon Cycle

Please read these Terms carefully and make sure that you understand them.

1. The Strathconon Cycle Ride is a fund raising event for Fairburn Memorial Hall and relies solely on volunteers.
2. You understand that it is your responsibility to cycle with care and attention and to understand and abide by the Rules, the UK Highway Code and any other rules stipulated by the Event Organiser before, during and after the Event.
3. If you are under 16 years old on the date of the Event, you may only participate in an Event if your parent or legal guardian has agreed to these conditions.
4. You agree to conduct yourself in a professional and cautious manner during your participation in the Event and understand that you may be disqualified from the Event if you do not do so. You accept that, in relation to your participation in the Event, the function of the marshals and relevant signage is only to indicate direction and that you must decide if the movement is safe.
5. You understand and agree that you participate in the Event entirely at your own risk, that you must rely on your own ability in dealing with all hazards, and that you must conduct yourself in a manner that is safe for yourself and all others throughout the duration of the Event.
6. If you have any medical condition/s, including allergies, which the Event Organiser or Event medical advisors might need to be aware of, you undertake that you have provided details of these on registration.
7. You accept full liability and responsibility for any medical expenses incurred as a result of training for and/or participating in the Event.
8. You accept that it is your responsibility to provide and use a suitable bicycle and helmet. The Event Organiser's decision is final as to whether the bicycle and helmet are suitable.
